Although, more often than not, it's a lost cause for displaced people to obtain refugee status. Consider that only one in five people who file for international protection are given refugee status. The vast majority of the world's refugees and displaced people remain outside UNHCR's mandate. Those who are recognized as refugees are often subjected to long and arduous bureaucratic processes for refugee status determination, often lasting more than 10 years. In a matter of seconds, even by using an online aid delivery app, the world can help someone fleeing for his or her life. Heidi Bauer has an easy answer for how we can help displaced and persecuted people. She started a new job this year: A two-month internship in Geneva, Switzerland with the United Nations' Organization of the Islamic Conference (OIC) and its Governing Council for the U.N. General Assembly, the highest political body of the OIC. It meets every year in New York to consider reforms to the United Nations, including the creation of a new security council. Bauer's current project is to work on migration. The OIC runs a \$60 million sub-agency of UNHCR, called the Office of the High Commissioner for Refugees (OHCHR), which coordinates development aid for refugees and makes sure that donors' money is spent appropriately. It's a different way to work, says Bauer, a vice president at U.S.-based advocacy group Access Now, as the organization helps advance political, legal and policy changes to ensure that refugees and internally displaced people have a better chance of obtaining refugee status. "The United Nations' system is very traditional," says Bauer. "It follows very strict rules, and it is very complicated for anyone who is not used to this world." In a typical refugee case, there are several different entities involved, including an applicant's state of origin, a state of application, the application for refugee status by the applicant's host country and the process of determining whether to grant refugee status or not. It's a system, she says, that has been designed to only recognize the most persecuted people. "There is this stereotype of a refugee who 82157476f
